Pre-Training Boat Rental Arrangement

1. Rental details

Coastal rowing boats are now available at the Jockey Club Shek Mun Rowing Centre for the valid centre users of the Hong Kong, China Rowing Association (HKCRA) whose meet the following respective qualifications to book and train specifically for the above event: -

Type of Coastal Boat	Hiring Fee	Eligibility
Coastal Doubles Boat (C2x) (Sculling)	\$30/hr/seat	1) Completed HKCRA’s Coastal Rowing Introductory Course (Stage 1 & 2) OR 2) Have to attend three hours Assessment Session under the HKCRA’s authorised coach who had assessed you are competent for open water rowing in coastal boats.
Coastal Coxed Quads Boat (C4x+) (Sculling)	\$30/hr/seat (except the Cox)	

Remarks:

- 1.1 For the boat rental, please reserve your seat by email and settle the payment at least two working days in advance of your booking date.
- 1.2 Reservation will be on **first-come first-served basis**.
- 1.3 Rower should prepare your own safety pack; This can contain items such as maps, safety items such as a whistle or flares, tools, and a simple medical kit (e.g. to deal with jellyfish stings) before you row.

2. Schedule for the Assessment

HKCRA will organise three assessment sessions for rowers who would like to have Pre-training for the above event. Details are given as below: -

- 2.1 We will gather the entry number and send you a confirmation email after the deadline. Once the confirmation letter is sent, no changing course, transferring and refund will be accepted.

- 2.2 When the course cannot be held as scheduled, HKCRA will inform those applicants by phone. If no notification is received in 2 days before the commencement of the course, please contact our staff for enquiry.
- 2.3 Fee included the coaches' fee and boat rental fee.
- 2.4 Rowers who pass the Assessment are eligible to rent boat for Zone 1 & 2 self-training activity until 3 November 2019.
- 2.5 The enrollment of Assessment will be on **first-come first-served basis**.
- 2.6 Make-up class may arrange if the course is affected by inclement weather. For detailed arrangement for inclement weather, please check HKCRA website.
- 2.7 HKCRA reserves the right to amend all course arrangement.
