- 1.1.To enhance rowing standard among schools by providing opportunities for students to compete with each other and make friends in the Championships.
- 1.2.To promote rowing in school by encouraging schools setting up school rowing team.

^ For Secondary Schools, each School can enter <u>only one crew</u> in each Single Scull Event.

3.Rules of Racing

3.1. "Rules of Racing" of Hong Kong, China Rowing Association (HKCRA) will be used in this Championships, details please visit:

3.2.Open event can consist of crews from different schools, age group (range 14-19) or gender (at least 1 female in each crew), however the results **will not be** counted in the overall points system.

4.Eligibility and Notice to Rowers

- 4.1.Rowers must be under 19 years old. (Valid Student Card should be presented during registration at the venue)
- 4.2. Entries must be endorsed by the respective school and participants must be the students of that school.
- 4.3. Rowers must be the students of the school in the current year 2021-2022.
- 4.4.Rowers must be able to swim at least 50 meters with clothes.
- 4.5.Rowers must have the rowing qualification of Star 3 or above issued by the HKCRA or equivalent rowing qualification.
- 4.6.Each rower can<u>only participate in maximum 2 different events</u>, and <u>cannot participate in more than one</u> <u>age group</u>. Open event is not limited by this rule.
- 4.7.If there is an excessive of entries in any event, participating schools can only enter <u>one crew</u> of that event.
- 4.8.HKCRA reserved the right to cancel if there are less than 3 participating crews and from less than 2 different schools.





5.Age Group

According to the Hong Kong Schools Sports Federation (HKSSF), the students' age grouping of 2021-22 are as follows: -

	A Grade	Under 19 - Date of birth on after 1 January 2003
Secondary School	B Grade	Under 16 – Date of birth on after 1 January 2006
	C Grade	Under 14 – Date of birth on after 1 January 2008
Primary School	A Grade	Under 13 – Date of birth on after 1 January 2009

6.Application Procedure

- 6.1. The completed Entry Form **(Annex 1)**, Declaration **(Annex 2)** and entry fee (paid via cheque or ATM) should return to the HKCRA by post or in person. (Address: Jockey Club Shek Mun Rowing Centre, No. 27 On King Street, Sha Tin. N.T) Please mark **'2021 HKRSC'** on envelope.
- 6.2. Entry Fee: HK\$80 / rower / event
- 6.3. Payment method:
 - By cheque : payable to "Hong Kong, China Rowing Association" with the school name written on the backside. Or;
 - Via ATM : please transfer the entry fee to the HSBC account: 002-6-187443, and write the school name on the bank-in-slip, email to (kelvin.k@rowing.org.hk) or fax to the HKCRA. (Fax no. 2601 4477)
- 6.4. The HKCRA will only process the application with completed entry form and full payment of the entry fee. The applicant should contact the HKCRA to re-confirm if your application is duly received.

7.Points System and Prizes

7.1.Trophies for the "Overall Champion, 1st runner-up and 2nd runner-up for Men's Events and Women's Events" will be presented to the <u>Secondary Schools</u> according to the points they gained. Points will be awarded as shown below:
