

#### Passion to go beyond 熱愛.無限 Hong Kong Rowing Beach Sprint Championships 2024

14<sup>th</sup> – 15<sup>th</sup> December, 2024

The 2024 Hong Kong Rowing Beach Sprint Championships will take place from 14<sup>th</sup> to 15<sup>th</sup> December 2024 at Silvermine Bay Beach, Lantau, Hong Kong. The Championships will be held following the World Rowing "Beach Sprint" format, using a shared pool of coastal solo (C1x) boats.

## **Beach Sprints**


Beach Sprints are an exciting and emerging discipline of rowing, which will be included for the first time in the Los Angeles 2028 Olympic programme. The inaugural World Rowing Beach Sprint Finals were held in Shenzhen, China in 2019. The 2024 World Rowing Beach Sprint Finals were held this year in September in Genoa, Italy. ## Hong Kong Beach Sprints

Racing will consist of a  $1^{st}$  round time-trial followed by a side-by-side knockout race format for the top 8 crews in each event. Racing includes a 30 - 50m run on sand from the start/finish line to the boats, a 250m slalom row around buoys placed 80 - 85m apart, a turn around the end buoy, a 250m direct sprint back to the beach, and finally a run back to the start/finish line.

A modified World Rowing progression system will be used depending on the number of entries.

## **Race Course**



The race course will be set in an open-water area on Silvermine Bay Beach. The race pattern is as shown above (Time-trial and Knock-out format).

#### **Entries and Fees**

*Competitors may enter only ONE major event and, if eligible, one sub-category*. Doubling-up is NOT permitted. There will be a fee of HK\$260 per entry, including use of the boats. No additional fees will be charged for named boat handlers who are not racing.

There is a limit of 40 entries for each major event category and entries will be accepted on a first-come-first-served basis. Please make entries and payment via the Google Form at this link. <u>https://forms.gle/n5NRKg8waTnRzixA6</u>

The deadline for entries is at 12:00 noon (Hong Kong time) on Monday 2<sup>nd</sup> December 2024. Entries without payment will not be accepted.

### Equipment

All racing will be in identical, shared-use, boats provided by the Organising Committee. The boats will be set on a standard rig with 158cm span. No adjustments can be made to the boats except for the foot stretcher position. Athletes may also use their own seat-pads to adjust their sitting height in the boat if they wish.

Athletes may bring their own oars. Otherwise, the Organising Committee will provide shared oars to use with the boats. No adjustment of shared oars can be made.

#### **Boat Handlers**

Clubs must provide their own boat handlers during each race in which they take part. Handlers are considered part of the team and will assist the crews launching and landing during racing, moving boats to and from the water, and checking foot stretchers etc. <u>Each crew must have two (2) boat handlers available for each race.</u> For clubs with more than one entry in an event, at least four (4) boat handlers should be available. These may be other athletes, club members, club coaches etc. Aside from the athlete and the two boat handlers, no other persons may be in the field-of-play area during racing.

*For each entry the names of two (2) boat handlers shall be listed on the entry form.* Boat handlers may include athletes racing in other major events. Athletes may not however act as boat handlers for crews in their own major event category. Boat handlers may be changed if needed during the competition but crews who do not have two boat handlers present at the event start time will not be allowed to compete.

Group (4-5 pax) Training Sessions with HKCRA CRM Coach: on first-come-first-served basis. Cost: \$186 per person (Applicable for the time slots listed below; each session lasts 4 hours). An optional Zoom session, led by World Rowing expert Chris Perry, will also be held on 9<sup>th</sup> December at 19:30 for any athletes and boat handlers with limited Beach Sprint experience. Tips on boat entry, exit, steering and Beach Sprint racing will be provided.

### Team Manager's Meeting

The meeting will be held via Zoom at 19:30 on 13<sup>th</sup> December 2024. Each Club shall assign at least one representative to attend as it will include important information on safety and other racing issues. Clubs not having a representative at the meeting maybe liable to be excluded from racing. Any withdrawal of entries must be confirmed by noon on the day of the meeting. Teams making withdrawals after the deadline may be penalised.

#### Eligibility

The Hong Kong Rowing Beach Sprint Championships are open to Ordinary Members who compete for their own Clubs or Organizations, or Members serving in the respective Disciplined Service or employed in the corporation for which they are entered.

No rower is allowed to compete for more than one Club at the Championships.

Each rower taking part in the event shall ensure that they have a state of health and fitness which is commensurate with the level of event entered.

Each rower shall have a basic swimming ability, including being able to swim 50m and float, keeping their head above water for at least 3 minutes.

Whilst the Organising Committee shall take all reasonable steps to provide safe rowing conditions, <u>the ultimate responsibility</u> for competing safely rests with each individual competitor and their teams.

Age limits and event categories correspond to those in the HKCRA Rules of Racing.

### Travel to Silvermine Bay Beach

By land: To get to Mui Wo use MTR to Tung Chung and then catch bus 3M from Tung Chung to Mui Wo.

By Sea: To get to Mui Wo catch the ferry from Central Pier Number 6. The Sun Ferry schedule can be checked online at <a href="https://www.sunferry.com.hk/assets/files/T\_MW\_2023.pdf">https://www.sunferry.com.hk/assets/files/T\_MW\_2023.pdf</a>

Once you arrive at Mui Wo Ferry Pier, turn right past the Mui Wo Cooked Food Market. Silvermine Bay Beach is only 10 minutes walk from there.
